Wates Construction Ltd is working in partnership with Cadogan Estates to deliver the 196-222 King's Road Project. The Project will provide retail/commercial space, a cinema, bars and residential properties, leaving a lasting legacy for the entire community.

Our progress to date

- Construction of the 'North Wing'- an office and plant space for the Waitrose store.
- Demolition of the Trafalgar Pub and Curzon/Habitat buildings.
- Piling works to the perimeter of the site boundary were completed summer 2020.
- Excavation of the basement (which will eventually house the new cinema).
- Constructed the first section of basement one level and the stair cores.
- Demolition of Regal House down to ground level.



Our upcoming works

- Demolition of the 198 Kings Road basement.
- Sub-structure works are ongoing within the main basement.
- Later in the year, the structure will be visible above the ground.
